The bond secured by Edgefield County School District in 1991 was paid off in March of 2018. That bond provided for the construction of three new schools and the renovation of four others. It has been twenty-five years since major facility needs have been addressed with the exception of the construction of the fieldhouse and the stadium renovation at Strom Thurmond High School. With the assistance of a consulting firm, the district has completed the first steps of a facility needs assessment.
